Qatar's legal system upholds equality

Rights of citizens, expats granted equal protection: Chief Justice

DOHA: Qatar has a fully independent judicial system that guarantees protection to the rights of the citizens and the residents in equal terms. The country's constitution and legal system are up to international standards, the Chief Justice Masood bin Mohammad Al Ameri said here yesterday.

Delivering the keynote address at the "Chief Justices Panel" on the concluding day of Qatar Legal Forum, the Chief Justice said the citizens and the residents must support each other in strengthening the rule of law.

Both these sections have equal access to the system to protect their respective rights. The Chief Justices panel addressed the question how to foster a global understanding and commitment to the rule of law. Chaired by The Lord Chief Justice of England and Wales, Lord Judge, the panel was comprised of the Chief Justices of Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Rwanda and The State of Queensland.

Lord Judge stressed that a global understanding to the rule of law need not involve a discussion based constitutional theory but one of the rule of law in peoples' everyday lives and realities, such as living in safety and having

enough to eat. The purpose of the Qatar Law Forum 2012 was to examine the rule of law from a global perspective, and over 60 countries were represented at the Forum. This great diversity in jurisdictions and cultures

were reflected in the remarks of the Chief Justices, as the audience heard accounts of the rule of law from a country which had emerged from genocide (Rwanda), reformed since the collapse of the Soviet empire (Azerbaijan) and where martial law was still in recent memory (Bangladesh). In stark contrast, Paul de Jersey, the Chief Justice of Queensland stated that although the rule of law is strong in his jurisdiction, the greatest challenge in Queensland was that it is taken for granted and there is a danger of complacency.

Lord Judge ended the session by looking to the rule of law in the future. He remarked how the speed of technological change was remarkable and the exchange of information between people of different nations across the globe would undoubtedly help to foster a greater global understanding of the rule of law in the coming years.

Highlights of the afternoon included a keynote speech from the Minister of Finance and Economy of Qatar H E Youssuf Hussein Kamal and sessions on the role of international courts in advancing the rule of law and freedom of communication and expression in times of change.

Qatar Charity to rehabilitate facilities at Al Quds University

DOHA: Qatar Charity (QC) will rehabilitate facilities at the Palestinian University of Al Quds at a cost of QR4.5m in a project to be funded by the Gulf Cooperation Council and the management of the Islamic Development Bank in Jeddah.

The project will improve facilities at Al Quds Open University in Rafah and Jabaliya, aiming to provide a suitable learning environment by improving infrastructure, as well as the quality of educational services provided at the university.

In Rafah, QC will build classrooms, an administrative area, a prayer room and student canteen, including electric fences and gates. At the Jabaliya site, QC will increase classrooms and provide a canteen, prayer room and elevators.

The improvements are expected to take around 12 months and QC will begin engineering plans and operational implementation over the coming weeks.

QC Palestine is currently running 13 projects helping those affected by the occupation, including the supply of medical equipment for university laboratories and the expansion and renovation of schools.

These projects are funded by the Qatar Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the GCC, plus private donors, and are valued at QR70m. QC Palestine will also provide 30 tonnes of sacrificed meat to the poor over the next few weeks.
